for Medieval Hebrew Manuscripts? Hebrew genitive clauses generally have certain syntactical features that delimit how they relate to their main clauses. When such a construction for Genesis 1:1 is analyzed in its relation to the main clause, the data shows that it lacks the syntactical features characteristic of genitive clauses in general. From a first comparison of the Gospel of Matthew with the two other Synoptic Gospels we find that 330 verses are peculiar to it alone; that it has between 330 and 370 in common with both the others, from 170 to 180 with Mark's, and from 230 to 240 with Luke's; that in like parts the same ideas are ...
