Share: Within each cycle are a preparatory season symbolized by the color purple and a festival season symbolized by the color white. After each cycle there is an ordinary time of growth symbolized the color green. Thus there is a sequence of seasons using purple, white, and green in that order twice each year. Purple and Blue. At Lent, purple suggests solemnity and penitence as the death and resurrection of Christ draws near. Some churches switch from purple to scarlet -- the color of blood -- for Holy Week, and most strip the sanctuary of all paraments from the conclusion of Maundy Thursday until Easter morning.
